



Call for Commissioners

The Accreditation Commission for Homeopathic Education in North America (ACHENA) is seeking individuals with a commitment to the growth of complementary and alternative medicine and expertise in higher education to serve as Commissioners. Since 1982, ACHENA has pursued its mission to promote excellence in the education of professional homeopaths by establishing educational standards and accrediting educational institutions and programs. ACHENA is affiliated with the Academic Consortium for Complementary and Alternative Health Care as an emerging profession and is a member of the Association of Specialized and Professional Accreditors.

Expertise Needed

ACHENA is seeking individuals with specific expertise and skills in the following areas:

- Higher education administration, pedagogy and curriculum development
- Higher education admissions and student recruitment
- Organizational management, finance and strategic planning
- Student assessment
- Student guidance and career placement
- Accreditation and self-study process

ACHENA Commissioners have a term of three years and act as agents of ACHENA with the following responsibilities:

1. Attend monthly one hour Commission meetings which are conducted by webinar platform
2. Become familiar with and support ACHENA educational standards and policies and procedures in an impartial and objective manner
3. Serve on at least one committee
4. Assist ACHENA in meeting its objective of recognition by the US Department of Education as an accrediting agency
5. Serve as a peer reviewer for at least one site visit during the three year term
6. Sign the ACHENA Conflict of Interest and Confidentiality Forms

After completing the training materials and becoming familiar with ACHENA educational standards and policies and procedures, the estimated monthly time commitment of a commissioner is 5- 10 hours.
